IN THE LIFE ON WPT LOOKS AT TRANSGENDER CHILDREN

April "In the Life" on WPT Looks at Transgender and Gender Nonconforming Children

This month's In the Life, "Becoming Me," airs 10 p.m. Tuesday, April 17 on Wisconsin Public Television (WPT).

Today many parents learn whether their baby is a boy or a girl before it is born, and most expect their children to develop a gender identity that mirrors biological sex within their first few years. However, for transgender and gender nonconforming children, gender identity unfolds throughout childhood, adolescence and into early adulthood.

"Becoming Me" features eight families with transgender and gender nonconforming children. Viewers will meet parents who must confront binary perceptions of gender, widespread transphobia and controversial parenting decisions while considering the healthy development of their children.
